3. The recent tendency to drop P<sub>5</sub> out of the limitation has been previously noted. In the past two weeks P<sub>5</sub> has not been seen in any solved traffic. This accounts for the increased number of depth solutions.

4. October production of plain text was over 3,300,000 letters--another new record.

5. Dragon has produced 20 solutions in addition to those already reported so that its total is now 55. The British are building two new Dragons and construction of one of them has already started. Estimated construction time is 3 months for the first, 4 for the second (from now).
