Biafran traffic from 1968?

In December 2019, just after we had made the first break into this traffic, Jan-Olof Grahn of the Swedish signal intelligence agency, Försvarets Radioanstalt — FRA, informed me that he had found three Biafran ciphertext messages in one of their files. The messages were not in the format they normally had when being received by radio, instead they were handwritten ciphertexts copied onto sheets of paper together with the station indicator, Biscaia, and their monthly date. Originally it was believed the messages were from 1969, however after they had been deciphered the plaintext made it clear that they must be from the year 1968.
